Host, Narrator, Geographer

Don Wildman is a unique geographer and host of popular television shows that take viewers to areas of the world not normally explored. Wildman's work has propelled him atop the list of the most recognizable faces in documentary television.

On the History Channel, he hosted *Cities of the Underworld* from 2007-2009 and is currently the host of the Travel Channel's new show *Off Limits*, where he takes part in dangerous, hands on, and extreme explorations that unlock secrets about cities and towns his audiences are otherwise familiar with.

Previously he hosted *The Incurables* on Veria from 2007-2008, *Weird Travels* on The Travel Channel from 2003-2005, and *Men's Journal* on ESPN. His trademark is one of an expert adventurer.

Wildman has also appeared in over 100 commercials, including an Oreo commercial that has been aired continuously for 18 years, and has been dubbed over in five different languages.

Living an interesting and exciting life, Wildman's career path and upbringing were unique as well. Raised in New Jersey as a Quaker, he attended Earlham College (a Quaker school) for his undergraduate years. After college, Wildman spent his time in London and throughout Europe, training at The Drama Studio. Upon his return to the United States, he sought out a career in politics while balancing his life acting.

Unsurprisingly, Wildman's favorite movies are action and war films. Similarly, he grew up idolizing Jacques Cousteau, and has fulfilled a life the legendary French explorer would be envious of. He learned to scuba dive at age 15 and has done his fair share of traveling both personally and for work. Aside from traveling in Europe while training as an actor, Wildman has visited every US state, except for Alaska.

He is also an avid hiker, bicyclist, and paddler, and is currently logging hours to earn a small-craft pilot's license. Wildman hopes that *Off Limits* will give him the opportunity to travel to places that he hasn't been, including Buenos Aires, Barcelona, and Rio de Janeiro.

After living for many years in New York City, Wildman and his wife relocated to Los Angeles. In his free time, he is fulfilling his dream of owning a British sports car by restoring a 1973 MG Midget.
